## **Extension of the After Final Consideration Pilot Program 2.0**

A Memorandum of Understanding between the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the Patent Office Professional Association

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) and the Patent Office Professional Association (POPA) extends the After Final Consideration Pilot 2.0 (AFCP 2.0) pilot, which ends on September 30, 2021, through FY 2022 (September 30, 2022).

The terms of the AFCP 2.0 program description and MOU dated September 23, 2014 are unchanged, however the Agency has determined to make the following changes:
